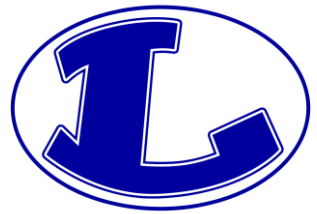

>>> MEDICATIONS

It is against district policy for students to carry medication with them on campus! This includes over the counter medications such as Tylenol, Ibuprofen, and cough drops. Emergency medications (i.e., Epi Pens, inhalers, and diabetic medications) are excluded with prior approval.

Medications are administered by campus nurses according to district policy in a safe and secure environment. Students are encouraged to take medication at home if possible.

Failure to abide by district policy will result in disciplinary action.
If your student needs medication while at school, please contact your campus nurse.
